Apex Park and Recreation District Community Access Fund Eligibility Guidelines

Applicant must be a District resident with a current District ID card. Applicant must provide proof of residency such as a utility bill or photo ID with current address to obtain a District ID card.

Applicant must show proof of need by supplying verification of one of the following: Free and Reduced lunch, WIC card, SNAP, TANF, Medicaid or other assistance.

Applications must be turned in at least three weeks prior to the start date of program requested. The maximum scholarship amount allowed is \$400.00 per individual, per year. Full and/or partial scholarships are available.

Information provided will not be shared with any other agency or personnel not directly associated with Community Access Fund requests.

Community Access Fund exclusions: Facility Passes, Golf green fees, cart fees, ice rental time, senior trips, district merchandise, AARP Senior Driver Safety Class, gift cards, facility rentals, contract programs and class supplies (if necessary for a program).
